

Certified School Nurse (CSN) Job Description

Qualifications/Previous Experience:

- → Holds a valid, active license issued through the Illinois Department of Professional and Financial Regulations as a Registered Nurse
- → Illinois State Board of Education Professional Educators License (PEL) with School Nurse endorsement
- → IDPH Hearing and Vision Technician certification
- → Experience in pediatric, special needs or school-based nursing is preferred
- → Experience writing and implementing IEPs and medical services plans
- → Excellent organizational, communication, and interpersonal skills

Key Responsibilities:

- → Reviews records and medical assessments, and creates reports (health histories) for annual and reevaluation meetings
- → Maintains, evaluates and interprets cumulative health data to accommodate the individual needs of students with a moderate to severe range of disabilities including Intellectual Disabilities, Autism, Emotional Disabilities and Multiple Disabilities that include students who are medically-fragile
- → Collaborates with the team in the development of IEPs and assists in identifying health related needs for other related services
- → Plans and coordinates direct professional nursing services, first aid, and emergency care for students and staff
- → Instructs, provides information or seeks appropriate support for staff regarding the health needs of students for staff, school district personnel, volunteers, and agency personnel
- → Continuously assesses, monitors, and evaluates student health needs
- → Prepare and submit paperwork in a timely manner, including medicaid billing
- → Ability to use own transportation to travel to sites throughout the MVSE Cooperative
