Candidates must not be afraid of heights, as the job requires the use of ladders, and must wear steel-toe shoes for safety. Apprentice I

Demonstrates aptitude or competence for assigned responsibilities.

Records work and leave time accurately and timely.

Records and turns in school district related purchases accurately and timely.

Must be able to lift heavy objects (50 lbs).

Ensures all assigned work meets current specifications of the supervisor.
