The mission of the Graduation Intervention Program Instructor is to support seniors through a nontraditional pathway to graduation.

Essential Functions and Responsibilities:

- 1. Work with counselors and administration to identify students for the graduation intervention program
- 2. Maintain spreadsheet of student credits and update accordingly
- 3. Assign student's online courses per their credit needs
- 4. Provide weekly progress data to relevant stakeholders
- 5. Support students academically in their online instruction
- 6. Monitor academic and attendance data
- 7. Schedule relevant speakers to address post-secondary success
- 8. Create supplemental assignments for students as needed
- 9. Maintains regular attendance
