- **g.** Always be alert and responsive to children
- h. Guide babies and toddlers through education/development programs
- i. Think on their feet and respond to each child's needs efficiently
- j. Display a patient and calm personality coupled with a loving approach to every child
- k. Contribute positively to the behavior and social interaction of the children
- **l.** Build secure relationships with children
- **m.** Report accidents, illnesses, and unusual behavior of children to the director and parents
- **n.** Assist in establishing routines

- o. Maintain a clean and functional environment
- **p.** Provide a safe and secure environment
- **q.** Ability to work effectively with diverse staff, parents, and community members
- r. Perform other duties as required
- s. Work closely with the director to ensure guidelines are adhered to
- t. Monitor and record the day's events for parent perusal
- **u.** Ensure close communication with parents to inform about the child's holistic health and to share and celebrate milestones

- a. Create bonds with colleagues to foster a healthy working environment
- **b.** Aid with other age groups when necessary
