- Experience with choral education or leading an ensemble. Voice is the primary instrument or main concentration during studies.
- Accompaniment music skills (piano, guitar preferred).
- A Master's Degree and valid NJ teaching certificate in the content area. (Bachelor's Degree is required.)
- Holds a minimum of a Bachelor's Degree and is eligible for a CE or CEAS, or holds a valid NJ teaching credential for the grade and/or subject required.
- Passion and sustained commitment to ensure that joyful, rigorous instruction is delivered to every scholar, every day.
- An entrepreneurial spirit, be mission-aligned
