

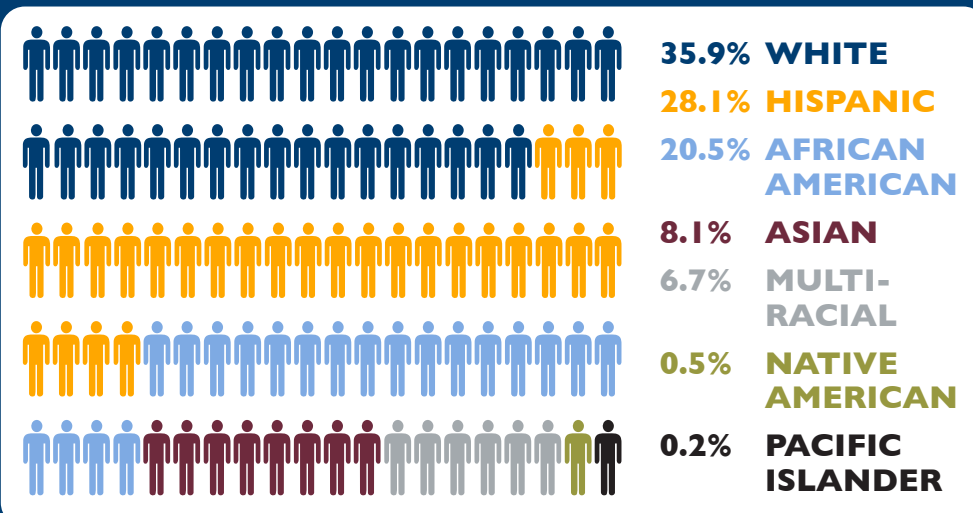


DISTRICT FACTS 2020-2021

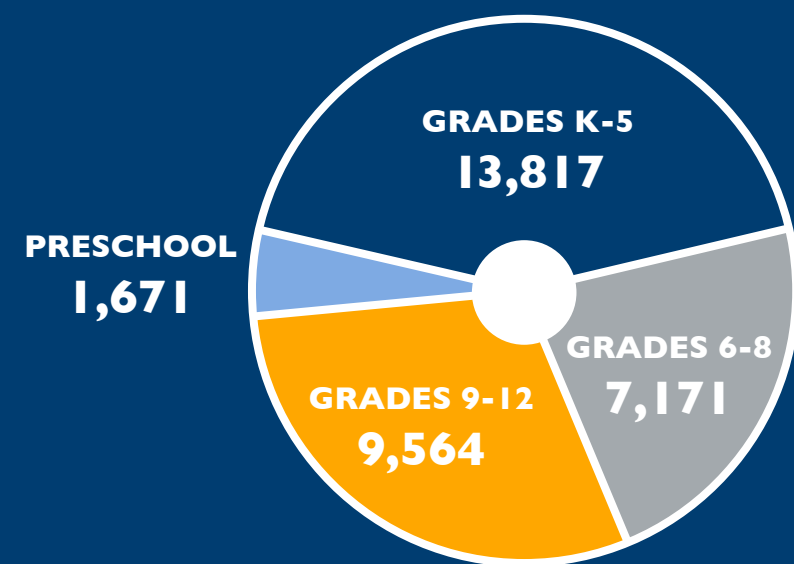
For more than 100 years, Des Moines Public Schools has educated the children of Iowa's capitol city.

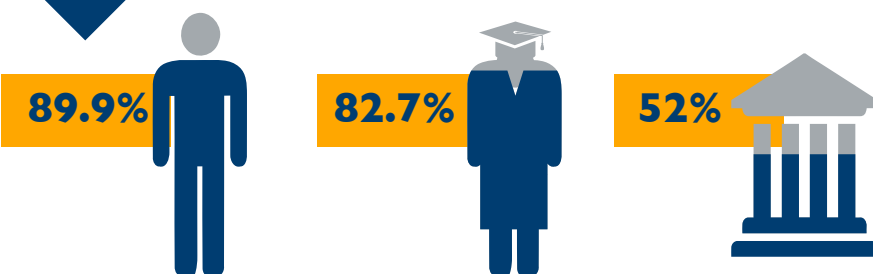
HEALTHY MEALS DURING 2019-2020

- The average number of breakfasts served per day was **13,799**
- The average number of lunches served per day was **21,362**
- Food pantries are housed in **19** of our community schools where an average of **1300** families per month are served

76% of DMPS student qualify for free or reduced-price meals



PERFORMANCE INDICATORS



- Average Daily Attendance = **89.9%** in 2019-20
- Graduation rate for the Class of 2019 = **82.7%**
- 52%** of the Class of 2018 enrolled in a post-secondary institution
- 7.82%** of students were classified as Gifted & Talented - 2019-2020

SUPPORT IN A VIRTUAL WORLD – VIRTUAL LEARNING FACTS

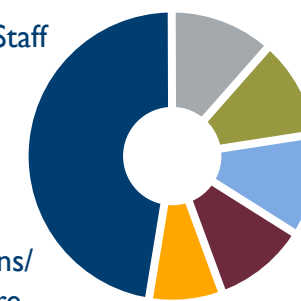
- Over **105,000** assignments / **40,718** discussion topics in Canvas

- DMPS average teacher salary: **\$60,086**
• Iowa Average: \$58,042
- 46.1%** of teachers have advanced degrees in Des Moines (compared to 37.4% statewide)
- First Year Teacher Salaries
 - Iowa average for new teachers: **\$42,540**
 - New BLUE contract teacher salary: **\$44,575**
 - DMPS average for new teachers (includes those with Masters): **\$43,375**
- 34** new teachers for a total of **165** earned a Master's Degree in Urban Education at no cost through the BLUE contract program

ARTISTS & ATHLETES

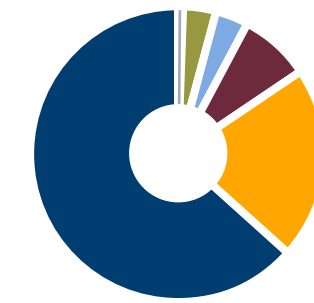
More than half of students participate in at least one extra-curricular activity or sport

- Students at DMPS were born in **109** different nations and speak more than **83** different languages
- Last year, DMPS welcomed **51** students who were new to the United States



TOP EDUCATIONAL OFFERINGS

- 10** International Baccalaureate World Schools with over **5,400** students
- 5** Turnaround Arts schools
- Cowles Montessori School** is currently the only public Montessori in the state of Iowa
- Two schools – the **Downtown School** and the **Walnut Street School** – are located within the city's central business district
- The Career & Technical Institute at **Central Campus** is one of the nation's top career-readiness schools in the country
- Central Academy**, a magnet school, is nationally recognized as a leader in Advanced Placement, college credit, and accelerated courses
- The new **Virtual Campus**, with **258** students currently enrolled, gives students in Des Moines and across Iowa the chance to earn their high school diploma online
