


DISTRICT FACTS 2020-2021


For more than 100 years, Des Moines Public Schools has educated the children of lowa's capitol city.

The average number of breakfasts served per day was 13,799


The average number of lunches served per day was 21,362

Graduation rate for the Class of 2019 = **82.7%**


