Requirements for Paraprofessional License (renewed every five (5) years:

- At least 19 years of age to serve students in prekindergarten through grade 12.
- **Beginning January 1, 2023**, you may qualify for the ELS-Paraprofessional license by meeting the requirements outlined below at age 18 but only may serve in prekindergarten through grade 8.
- One of the following required:
 - Associate's degree or higher
 - o 60 semester hours of coursework
 - High School Diploma or GED and a score of 460 or higher on the ETS Parapro
 - High School Diploma or GED and the following scores on the ACT Workkeys:
 - Applied Mathematics/Applied Math (with a score of 4)
 - Reading for information/Workplace Documents (with a score of 4)

Short-Term Approval Requirements (valid for three (3) years):

- High School diploma (or equivalent) or higher
- While working on an approval, educator must be fulfilling requirements for the full license
- Applications are available until June 30, 2025 and may not be renewed

Job Description

Position: Blended Learning Student Supervisor

Reports to: Principal/Assistant Principals

Qualifications: High School Diploma

Educator License with Stipulations (ELS) / Paraprofessionals

Experience working with age-appropriate students

Terms of Employment: 9-month position

Basic Function: Under the direction of the school administrators, maintains optimum

student supervision and assistance in common spaces (cafeteria, library, hallways, restrooms, and grounds) as assigned by the administration.

Performance Responsibilities:

- 1. Knowledgeable of school rules and procedures as they appear in the Belvidere Community Unit School District 100 handbooks. Assists administration by enforcing school rules, policies and procedures.
- 2. Report students in non-compliance with the rules and regulations to the assistant principals.
- 3. Responsible for monitoring conduct and control of students present in common spaces to include the library, cafeteria, hallways, restrooms, and exits and entrances of the building.
- 4. Supervises hallways verifying student hall passes and reports to the assistant principals' students in the hallways and restrooms without authorization.
- 5. Supervises blended and traditional study halls, as assigned
- 6. Monitor school parking lots reporting students in non-compliance with the rules and regulations to the assistant principals.
- 7. Observe and view the school surveillance system reporting suspicious behavior of students to the assistant principals.
- 8. Patrol areas to prevent fire, theft, vandalism and illegal entry.
- 9. Works cooperatively with students, staff, and administration in maintaining students' welfare, health, and safety.



- 10. Carries out specific assignments as directed by the principal and/or assistant principals.
- 11. Establishes and maintains a positive relationship with students and staff.
- 12. May perform other related duties from time to time as assigned.
