Retirement Plan
 Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund (IMRF) is available for non-certified employees scheduled to work over 600 hours – 4.5% deducted and sheltered, Employee-paid 403(b) plan available for employee-paid contributions through payroll deductions with a District 87-approved vendor
Hourly Wage Rates
Step – Number of years an employee has been employed, new employees are granted credit at the rate of one year for each of the first five years of paraprofessional or teaching experience at a PreK-12 ISBE-recognized school
