TITLE: PHYSICAL THERAPIST

QUALIFICATIONS: Will hold an Ohio license for Physical Therapy.

REPORTS TO: Director of Special Education

JOB GOAL: To diagnose and service students with disabilities whose education is

adversely affected by their motor skills and abilities

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Provide a physical therapy evaluation as part of the multifactored evaluation.

- 2. Assists in the development of the individualized education program
- 3. Provides therapy which will:
 - a. Improve, develop or restore functions impaired or lost through illness, injury or deprivation.
 - b. Improve ability to perform tasks for independent functioning if functions are impaired or lost: and
 - c. Prevent, through early intervention, initial and further impairment or loss of function.
 - d. Improve or maintain strength and/or range of motion and encourage motor and reflex development.
- 4. Functions as a consultant with the child's parent and school personnel
- 5. Directs and supervises the activities of the physical therapy assistant
- 6. Instructs parents and teachers in the use of techniques and equipment
- 7. Recommends adaptive equipment to aid students in performing ambulation physical exercise, communication skills, wheelchair activities, and proper positioning
