1. Identifies students needing Adaptive P.E. services.

- 3. Writes and monitors IEPs for students who qualify for Adaptive P.E. services.
- 4. Attends IEP meetings when needed.
- 5. Works with special education teachers, regular education teaches and P.E. teachers to develop an appropriate program for Adaptive P.E. students.
- 6. Provides an instructional program that is appropriate to the individual needs of each student served.
- 7. Works with individuals and groups on motor abilities, coordination, physical and social-psychological performance.
- 8. Adapts the regular P.E. program to meet the needs of Adaptive P.E. students.
- 9. Provides in-service to school personnel and members of the community as needed.
- 10. Provides consultation to children, parents, teachers and administrator.
- 11. Maintains communication with building P.E. instructors, special education teachers and principals and special education administrative staff.
- 12. Performs other duties as requested by the Coordinator of Special Education.
