



Job Title: Elementary Summer Acceleration Teacher

Reports to: Campus Administrator

Dept./School: Assigned Summer School Campus

Rate of Pay: \$45/hour

Primary Purpose:

This position will provide direct instruction to students focusing on accelerating students in STAAR testing areas in a 15:1 student to teacher ratio.

Qualifications:

- Position is open to current Certified EISD teacher only (teachers retiring at the end of this school year are not eligible).
- Must be knowledgeable of instructional program, routines, and management

Work Schedule:

- June 2 – June 12 (9 days)
- Monday through Friday
- 7:30 am – 4:00 pm
- No additional training dates will be held

Major Responsibilities and Duties:

1. Engage and motivate students by providing targeted learning experiences.
2. Implement selected curriculum with fidelity.
3. Encourage daily student attendance.
4. Supervise and assist with the physical care of students including mealtimes, transitions, breaks, arrival/dismissal.
5. Ensure the safety and wellbeing of students.
6. Assist with maintaining a safe, neat, and orderly area.
7. Follow District guidelines in maintaining classroom management, discipline, and confidentiality.
8. Assist students with the proper use of technology.
9. Communicate with parents on a regular basis.
10. Maintain accurate documentation of student attendance and services received
11. Provide access to at least 30 hours of instruction in a 15:1 student to teacher ratio.
12. Perform other duties as assigned.

Mental/Physical/Environmental Factors:

Maintain emotional control under stress; Continual walking, standing, stooping, kneeling, bending, and twisting; Work indoors and outdoors in varying climate conditions.
