

**Job Title:** Summer School Registered Nurse (RN)/Licensed Vocational Nurse (LVN)

**Reports to:** District/Campus Administrator

**Dept./School:** District-Wide

Rate of Pay: \$45/hour RN, \$20/hour LVN

### **Primary Purpose:**

The Summer School RN will provide first aid to students and sta □. First aid includes, but not limited to administering medications, performing ordered treatments, caring for illness, and critical decision making in emergency situations.

## **Qualifications:**

- Internal posting for current full-time Nurses only. (Staff retiring at the end of this school year are not eligible, nor are employees still on contract.)
- Must be knowledgeable of nursing practices and protocols.

#### Work Schedule:

- Position 1- June 2-12, Position 2- June 2-27
- Monday through Friday
- 7:30am-4:00pm

## **Major Responsibilities and Duties:**

- 1. Provide direct care utilizing professional assessment skills, the nursing process, and established school health protocols.
- 2. Serve as health advocate for students.
- 3. Notify parents of accident or illness and secure medical care for students in emergency cases (if parents or emergency contact cannot be reached).
- 4. Coordinate management system to administer medications to students at school.
- 5. Administer medications according to district policy and procedures.
- 6. Provide health counseling and instruction to individual students.
- 7. Serve as health liaison between school, physicians, parents, and community.
- 8. Assess student problems and make appropriate referrals working with students, teachers, parents, and medical and health care professionals as needed.
- 9. Collaborate with other professionals regarding implementation of health-related Individual Education Plan (IEP) items.
- 10. Participate in assessment and reporting of suspected child abuse.

- 11. Communicate regularly with principal, health services coordinator, school counselor, teachers, parents, food services, and other staff regarding health services issues.
- 12. Comply with policies established by federal and state laws, Texas Department of Health rule, State Board of Education rule, and board policy in health services area.
- 13. Report potential health and safety hazards to campus principal.

# Mental/Physical/Environmental Factors:

Maintain emotional control under stress; Continual walking, standing, stooping, kneeling, bending, and twisting; Work indoors and outdoors in varying climate conditions.
