Primary Purpose:

Responsible for developing and implementing cheerleading programs for a school or organization. Teach cheerleading techniques, plan routines, choreograph dances, and train students to perform at events and competitions.

- Strong understanding of cheerleading rules and regulations
- Excellent communication and leadership skills
- Ability to motivate and inspire team members

Special Knowledge/Skills:

- Knowledge of coaching techniques and procedures
- Knowledge of University Interscholastic League (UIL) rules
- Ability to instruct and supervise student athletes
- Ability to pass U.S. Department of Transportation alcohol and drug tests and annual physical (include if bus driving duties are required)
- Excellent organizational, communication, and interpersonal skills

Experience

Minimum 3 years of experience in cheerleading, to include high school/college experience

Major Responsibilities and Duties:

- Developing and implementing a training program suitable for the cheerleaders' skill level
- Teaching cheerleaders various cheers, routines, stunts, and tumbling techniques
- Ensuring all cheerleading activities are conducted in a manner that promotes safety
- Organizing and conducting practice sessions to improve team's performance
- Choreographing routines and selecting music for performances and competitions
- Evaluating individual cheerleader's performance and providing constructive feedback
- Organizing transportation for cheerleaders to and from events and competitions
- Communicating with parents, school administrators, and other coaches about the progress of the team
- Ensuring that the team's routines and performances comply with competition rules and regulations
- Managing and maintaining cheerleading equipment and uniforms
- Developing a team spirit and positive attitude among the cheerleaders

Tools/Equipment Used: Athletic equipment, standard office equipment including computer and peripherals, and other instructional equipment; automated external defibrillator (AED); operate school bus
