- 5. Promotes self-esteem by showing respect for an understanding of students as learners.
- 6. Establishes effective instructional management procedures and promotes student time on task.
- 7. Sets realistic expectations geared to success.
- 8. Evaluates and reports achievement to students, parents, and principal.
- 9. Monitors student progress and maintains records of student achievement.
- 10. Cooperates with colleagues in planning and implementing instructional goals and objectives to serve the needs of students.
- 11. Communicates and exhibits positive interpersonal relationships.
- 12. Plans for and utilizes support staff when applicable.
- 13. Participates in building and district level planning and decision-making processes.
- 14. Pursues professional growth in accordance with State recertification requirements.
