Job Title/Description: Jr/Sr High School Behavior Interventionist

The Secondary MTSS Behavior Interventionist will perform duties under the direct MTSS director, Special Services Director or building principal. The interventionist will provide comprehensive services for behavior support (PBIS/PPSC).

#### Role and Responsibilities:

- Implements program-wide and individual student behavior intervention programs, including monitoring behavior data collection, preparing incident reports, verbal de-escalation, physical intervention (CPI training provided) and implementation of reward system under the direction of administration and classroom teachers.
- Supervises and monitors students within non-structured settings (i.e. arrival, departure, lunch and recess).
- Assists in the development, maintenance, and adaptation of instructional materials under the direction of classroom teachers.
- Records attendance, maintains records, and performs other clerical tasks under the direction of classroom teachers.
- Cleans and sanitizes classroom equipment according to district standards.
- Supervises students under teacher direction within school or community based instructional settings.
- Monitors the medical needs of and administers medication to students with a large responsibility focused on diabetic needs.
- Work collaborative as member of building Multi-Tiered Systems and Support (MTSS) team.
- Responsible for maintaining confidentiality for all school-related information.

- Provides group or individualized academic instruction, remediation or guided practice using instructional objectives and lessons developed by the teacher.
- Assumes other duties and responsibilities as assigned by classroom teachers or the supervising administrator.

Qualifications:

- A high school diploma or equivalent
- Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university preferred.
- Teacher Certification preferred
- The demonstrated ability to use basic office and audiovisual equipment is required.
- The demonstrated ability to communicate verbally and in writing is required.
- The demonstrated ability to work with students at varying age/developmental levels is required.
- The demonstrated ability to work with computer programs including basic word processing is desired.
