ILLUSTRATIVE RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES:

- Organizing practices and MMAC Season Games:
- Monitoring the academic progress of student athletes throughout the season
- Include issuing and collecting uniforms
- **Collection of Athletic Registration Fees**
- Providing an orientation of a sound training and expectations to all student athlete participants: tackling, blocking, route running, offensive and defensive alignment
- Developing fundamental skills, coachability, team concept, understanding roles. Developing mental performance and leadership skills.
- Communicating with the Varsity/JV Coach and Athletic Director on the progression of the student athletes in the program.
- Off Season lifting/speed and agility training.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Applicants must have knowledge and football. Flexible schedule and the ability to work with student athletes in a positive mentoring fashion. Experience in coaching at the middle school or higher levels. Must have played the sport as an athlete. Understand the MHSAA safety standards, and play within the rules of the NFHS guidelines.

Experience: recommended to have at least 2 years coaching football. Understand both offense and defensive coaching philosophies. Applicant must be certified in CPR/AED.
