Applicants must have knowledge and experience in sideline and competitive cheer. Flexible schedule and the ability to work with student athletes in a positive mentoring fashion. Experience in coaching competitive cheer at the middle school or high school level. Understanding of the scoring process and application of filling out score sheets.

Experience: Minimum of 2 years of competitive cheer under MHSAA Rules and Guidelines. Knowledge and understanding of the Cheer Manual, current member of the CCCAM or Cheer Association. Have Post Season MHSAA tournament competition experience. Applicant must be certified in CPR/AED.
