#### **REQUIREMENTS:**

- C. Experience Desired: Teaching experience preferred but not required

#### **ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:**

- 1. Must be able to write valid IEPs and to follow IDEA.
- 2. Must be able to teach programs according to IEPs for students with verified handicapping conditions.
- 3. Must be able to assist subject matter instructors in collaborative instructional models.
- 4. Must provide leadership and supervision of students in developing, organizing, and utilizing resources for an effective instructional program at the middle school level.
- 5. Must assist in program evaluation on a regular basis and participate in appropriate in-service development programs.
- 6. Must provide a safe orderly learning environment and assist in the supervision and direction of students as assigned.
- 7. Must provide a variety of learning experiences in which students are actively engaged as participants in the lesson
- 8. Must comply with state mandates for the education of verified students.
- 9. Conduct Functional Behavioral Assessments and Behavioral Intervention Plans for students.
- 10. Assist and support building staff and parents in the development, implementation, and revision of student behavior intervention plans.
- 11. Must have excellent interpersonal skills to consult effectively with teachers, administrators, and parents, in a variety of settings.
- 12. Must be flexible and adapt to change.
- 13. Must have the ability to interface with people (groups and individuals) and communicate within various mediums (E-mail, telephone).

### PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

Occasional: bending/stooping, reaching/pushing/pulling, climbing, driving, lifting 10# max, carrying 20 ft.

Frequent: standing, walking, sitting, manual dexterity tasks
