

Title: Elementary Extended Learning Time Teacher Pool

Location: Various Schools Throughout the District

Compensation: Teacher Regular Hourly Salary

Schedule: Hours of program operation are outside of regular, contracted school day; May include intermittent periods of school breaks to meet the needs of students.

The Elementary Extended Learning time (ELT) teacher is responsible for providing targeted academic support to students identified as needing additional assistance in core subjects like reading and math, outside of regular school hours, by utilizing specialized instructional strategies to help them achieve grade level standards.

Key responsibilities:

- The ELT Teacher will deliver focused instruction in small groups to address specific learning gaps in reading, math, or other subject areas.
- The ELT Teacher will employ a variety of teaching methods and materials to cater to diverse learning styles and needs within the group.
- Regularly assess student progress through formative and summative assessments to track learning gains and adjust instructional strategies as needed.
- Utilize data to inform instructional decision, identify trends, and evaluate the effectiveness of interventions.
