## **JOB SUMMARY**

The PC/ Network Technician role is to support and maintain in-house computer networks, desktops, and peripherals. This includes installing, diagnosing, repairing, maintaining, and upgrading all hardware and equipment while ensuring optimal workstation performance. The person will also troubleshoot problem areas in a timely and accurate fashion, and provide end user training and assistance where required.

- Diagnose and repair classroom audio equipment, projector, and display issues.
- Updates and troubleshoots all other software used by staff and students
- Performs physical movement of computer hardware from area to area or for disposition.
- Provides training in software and hardware operations and maintenance to end-users.
- Supports the system's technology help desk
- Assists in the evaluation of new forms of technology and functionality to aid student learning and teacher instruction.
- Handles essential (technological) set-up of school events and conferences.
- Coordinates beginning and end of year procedures for all staff.
- Works in tandem with media specialists and inventory specialists to maintain accurate records of assets.
- Coordinates and manages distribution of student devices and assignments for each school.
- Investigates and reports potential cybersecurity incidents to the Network Manager
- maintains prompt and regular attendance as physical attendance on the job site is required.
- Performs all other duties as assigned by supervisor (i.e. cameras, recordings, password resets)
