### **ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND TASKS:**

- Demonstrates prompt and regular attendance
- Exhibits professionalism
- Follows all county, state, and federal policies and procedures
- Assists the bus driver, parents, and school personnel with the safety, movement, management, and care of the children boarding the school bus, leaving the bus, or being transported
- Consults with and assists bus driver in the documentation of student information, recordkeeping, and completing route surveys
- Lifts students as required; ensure appropriate and responsible adult meets students exiting the bus
- Seats self in an area on the bus to ensure observation of all passengers at all times and make sure they are following school bus safety rules
- Assists the school bus driver in reporting infractions of school bus safety
- Maintain order of passengers; resolve disputes
- Operates the two-way communication equipment correctly and according to transportation policy
- Operates adaptive transportation lift to board and discharge challenged passengers using safe and responsible procedures



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#### **ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND TASKS CONTINUED:**

- Maintains a cooperative attitude with fellow employees, supervisors, and passengers, always promoting goodwill
- Perform other duties as required

#### POSITION TYPE AND EXPECTED HOURS OF WORK:

Daily hours will be approximately four hours, generally Monday through Friday. Occasional evening and weekend work may be required as job duties demand.
