DISTRICT DESCRIPTION: Houghton Lake Community Schools has approximately 1,140 students and is located in the center of the Lower Peninsula in northern Michigan. We have about 100 school of choice students from outside of the district and county.

The District has three preschool classrooms with additional preschools available within the community. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Conduct pre-trip inspection of school bus prior to every trip and route as prescribed.
- Only use established routes and designated bus stops.
- Operate bus/district vehicle on approved time schedule.
- Obey all traffic laws, regulations and procedures.
- Observe all mandatory safety and radio check regulations.
- Maintain discipline when students are on bus.
- Report bus accidents and pupil injuries to authorities and complete required reports.
- Conduct emergency evacuation drills in keeping with school policies and laws.
- Instruct riders regarding being responsible passengers.

PROFESSIONAL QUALIFICATIONS:

Required:

- High School Diploma or equivalent.
- Must pass DOT physical.
- Must possess a valid Michigan driver's license.
- Must have or be able to obtain a B, P, and S endorsement and a CDL.
- Must have or must attend School Bus Driver Certification Classes.
- Must have a clean driving record.
