DISTRICT DESCRIPTION: Houghton Lake Community Schools has approximately 1,100 students and is located in the center of the Lower Peninsula in northern Michigan. Our families enjoy the benefits of living in an area thriving on tourism as most of our district surrounds beautiful Houghton Lake. We have about 100 school of choice students from outside of the district and county. Currently, 17% of our students qualify for special education services.

The District has two preschool classrooms with additional preschools available within the community. There is one PreK-6th grade elementary school, one 7th-12th grade junior/senior high school and extensive alternative education opportunities. Career and technical education opportunities are available as well as several Advanced Placement and Dual Enrollment college courses.

- provide direct professional nursing services, first aid, illness and emergency care to students in response to and in accordance with professional standards, school policies and procedures, and state and local mandates
- administer medication as required by IEP and 504 plans, and maintain accurate medical records to ensure compliance with state and school mandates including immunizations, physical examinations, and medical conditions and the related archival responsibilities in MCIR, and reports to the local health department
- make appropriate assessment and referrals for suspected abuse/neglect as a mandated reporter and collaborate with other school staff and administration
- communicate with teachers, case managers, social workers, other school personnel, and parents/guardians of Collins Elementary School to enhance cooperative action, which will meet the health and safety needs of our students
- other duties as assigned

- Associates degree or Bachelor's degree in Nursing, RN
- Certification as a school nurse, OR begin certification process once hired
