The Frist Grade Fundamentals program is for students entering First Grade for the 2025-2026 School Year. Students will be engaged in interactive, meaningful literacy experiences through daily read-alouds and shared readings. They will gain important pre-reading/writing concepts such as print awareness, phonological awareness, letter/sound knowledge, oral language, vocabulary, comprehension, and writing fluency. Classes will be capped at 10 students per class this year.
