Program Synopsis:

The STEM Literacy program is for students entering Second Grade through Fourth Grade for the 2025-2026 School Year. Students will engage with high-interest science-based texts to develop vocabulary, fluency, and comprehension strategies. Text levels vary between the beginning of second grade and end of fourth grade. (Students reading below an early second grade reading level may struggle with the materials.) Students will also have opportunities to interact with science and engineering through activities and investigations focused on developing rich content knowledge. Classes will be capped at 10 students per class this year.

Certification Requirements & Qualifications:

- Valid Michigan Teaching Certificate
- Experience teaching Early Elementary (*required*)
- Enthusiastic, energetic, and positive professionals
- Experience working with students in individual and group settings to support learning
- Ability to successfully pass a background check

Required Skills:

- Ability to work cooperatively with students, parents, and colleagues
- Effective communication skills, both orally and in writing
- Good organizational and problem-solving skills
- Self-directedness and initiative when given a variety of tasks and responsibilities.
- Possess physical abilities sufficient to employ physical intervention strategies when necessary, i.e. non-violent crisis intervention techniques
- Enthusiastic and takes initiative

Responsibilities:

*Include but are not limited to the following

- Administering pre- and post-assessments;
- Planning and providing daily instructional activities/lessons for each day of camp;
- Planning appropriate instruction based on assessment/s and to support student need; maintaining lesson plans;
- Providing activities (using the learning kits) that families can do with their children each week;
- Encourage families to read daily with their children.
