POSITION: Day-to-Day Substitute Teacher

**RATE**: Effective April 7, 2025

- \$165 (full day) / \$82.50 (half day) for assignments Monday through Thursday
- \$175 (full day) / \$87.5 (half day) for Friday assignments

**JOB GOAL**: To administer the instructional plans provided by the teacher of record and classroom operation in compliance with instructions of the Administration, pertinent laws, state and federal regulations, and Board of Education Policies.

## **EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE**

- Bachelor's degree required.
- An understanding of teaching and the duties of a teacher as an educational leader.
- Eligibility to hold a valid emergency permit as issued by the Department of Education, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- Demonstrated ability to work with various groups of people in an educational environment.

## **AUTHORITY AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Responsible for the overall operation and management of the assigned classrooms, students and instruction.
- Effectively direct and manage students, and delegate assignments.
- Report student progress to the classroom teacher.
- Ability to work as an instructional leader and member of a team.
- Exercise good judgment in prioritizing tasks.
- Ability to operate office equipment and to use computer technology efficiently.
- Oversees the activities of a paraprofessional or volunteer if one is assigned to the classroom.
- Works cooperatively with peers to deliver needed instructional programs and services to
- In conjunction with the Administration, shall provide for classroom security through the development, implementation and maintenance of a safety plan.

## **PHYSICAL DEMANDS:**

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions. with or without the use of aids.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to talk and hear. The employee is frequently required to walk, sit, use hands for fine manipulation, handle or feel and reach with hands and arms using a keyboard and video display terminal. The employee is occasionally required to stand and stoop, kneel, crouch or crawl and climb stairs. The employee must regularly lift and/or move up to 10 pounds and occasionally up to 25 pounds. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision.

**TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT:** The Day-to-Day Substitute Teacher position is assigned on an as needed basis. Jobs are selected on the Frontline system as available.

**BENEFITS:** No benefits are offered for this position.
