<u>SUMMARY:</u> Under general supervision, serves as classroom teacher for and creates a flexible program and environment favorable to learning and personal growth in accordance with each student's ability.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES REQUIRE THE ABILITY TO:

- Provide learning experiences and teach the course of study prescribed by the District approved curriculum.
- Develop and use instructional material suitable for verbal and/or visual instruction of students with wide range of mental physical and emotional maturity.
- Evaluate academic and social growth of students and keeps appropriate records.
- Provide appropriate instruction and activities for students to meet school/ District policies goals and objectives.
- Communicate with parents through a variety of means.
- Hold parent conferences to discuss the individual student progress and interpret the school program.
- Identify student needs and cooperate with other professional staff members in assessing and helping students solve health and learning problems.
- Create an effective environment for learning through functional and attractive displays such as bulletin boards, interest centers etc.
- Maintain professional competence through in-service education activities provided by the District and/or professional growth activities and university courses.
- Participate cooperatively with the appropriate administrator to develop the method by which the student will be evaluated in conformance with District guidelines.
- Select and requisition instructional materials; maintain inventory records.
- Perform other duties as assigned.
- Have vocal interaction, written communication and environmental assessment.
- Participate in faculty and/or District committees and the sponsorship of student activities
- Cooperate in school-wide supervision of students during out-of-classroom activities.

EDUCATION and/or EXPERIENCE: Bachelor's degree including all courses to meet credential requirements. Student teaching internship or full-time teaching experience.

CREDENTIAL: Valid Colorado Credential or license authorizing service in grade levels and areas assigned.

DESIREABLE CHARACTERISTICS:

- Professional and approachable appearance and personality, which establish a desirable example for students.
- Ability to meet District standards for physical and mental health.
- Above-average recommendations from student teaching supervisors and other professionals who have observed the characteristics scholastic attainment and classroom performance of the teacher.
- Tact and ability to work with a diverse group of students.
