**Primary Purpose:**

Under general supervision, provide a safe and secure learning environment through maintaining irrigation systems at all district campuses under the direction of the Irrigation Lead.

**Qualifications:**

**Minimum Education/Certification**

- High School Diploma/GED
- Valid Texas Driver License.
- Driving record that meets the requirements of the district's insurance carrier.
- Texas State Irrigation License or ability to obtain within one year from date of hire.

**Special Knowledge/Skills/Experience:**

- General knowledge of design and installation of irrigation systems
- Knowledge of applicable building codes
- Possess a positive attitude
- Three years' experience in irrigation installation and maintenance.

**Major Responsibilities and Duties:**

- Install district's irrigation systems
- Perform major and minor repairs to irrigation systems.
- Perform preventative maintenance on irrigation systems and equipment.
- Responsible to audit systems for uniform coverage and water conservation.
- Responsible for managing watering schedules.
- Perform other duties as assigned

**Mental Demands/Physical Demands/Environmental Factors:**

- Maintenance equipment such as propane torch; hand tools; power tools; heavy equipment including forklift, trencher, backhoe; irrigation related equipment, hand-tools, shop equipment, district vehicles/trailers and safety equipment
- Frequent standing, kneeling/squatting, bending/stooping, pushing/pulling, and twisting; work in tiring and uncomfortable positions
- Frequent reaching, standing, walking, and climbing
- Frequent lifting and carrying (45 pounds and over) on a daily basis.
- Work outside on slippery or uneven walking surfaces; frequent exposure to extreme hot and cold temperatures, dust, toxic chemicals and fumes, noise, vibration, and electrical hazards; work around gas lines; work around machinery with moving parts; may work in tight or enclosed spaces; may work alone; regularly work irregular hours; occasional prolonged hours; frequent districtwide travel

- Maintain emotional control under stress; work with frequent interruptions

**OTHER:** All employees are to follow district safety protocols and emergency procedures.
