- 4. Scoring and interpreting assessment results related to eligibility for speech/language services as part of a Multidisciplinary Evaluation Team.
- 5. Summarizing assessment information by giving a profile of strengths and weaknesses of individual students.
- 6. Interviewing students, parents and teachers.
- 7. Preparing written communication profiles.
- 8. Developing Individualized Educational Plan.
- 9. Providing in-service to parents, educators, and/or others on issues related to speech/language development and services.
- 10. Consulting with other professionals on communications impairments in both special and general education.
- 11. Managing the Individual Educational Planning Committee process for speech and language impaired students and participating in the I.E.P.C. for students who receive speech and language as an ancillary service.
