Essential Duties and Responsibilities

Duties include but are not limited to the following:

- Employee will provide and use their own hand tools such as hammers, screw drivers, etc.
- Open school buildings as appropriate
- Assist with any area of the grounds as needed
- Spot check to see that all building systems are functioning properly
- Maintain district heating system in all buildings
- Responsible for cleaning and preparation for State Department inspections and the issuance of yearly licenses
- Maintain and repair fans, motors, pumps, etc. as necessary
- Check all outside and inside electrical installations and equipment periodically. Maintain and repair as necessary
- Remove snow and ice district wide as needed
- Check all water lines periodically. Maintain and repair as necessary
- Communicate building maintenance needs to Operations Director
- Assist in developing specifications for repair/maintenance projects
- Collaborate with Operations Director to coordinate outside contractors with building maintenance projects
- Maintain appropriate inventory of necessary supplies
- Assist in developing and maintaining appropriate maintenance and preventative maintenance records
- Complete plumbing, HVAC, electricity and carpentry and construction projects as assigned or needed
- Support the mission of Mason Consolidated School District
- Communicate positively and effectively with all co-workers and recipients of services
- Prepare Athletic Fields/Venues/Facilities for District events
- Drive bus as needed for repairs, delivery or other emergency situations (CDL required)

 Director and/or Superintendent
