### **POSITION SUMMARY:**

A Lifeguard employed with the Metropolitan School District of Washington Township is responsible for the health, safety and welfare of the class participants who use the North Central swimming pool. A Lifeguard's major responsibility is to observe swimmers and enforce regulations in the guarding of life and the prevention of accidents. This position will report the Athletic Director or his designee.

#### **ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- 1. Monitor activities at the pool to prevent accidents.
- 2. Report behavior issues or unsafe practices to the head swim coach or his/her designee.
- 3. Rescue swimmers or pool participants in danger of drowning.
- 4. Administer First Aid.
- 5. Caution swimmers regarding unsafe practices and safety hazards; enforces and adheres to pool rules and regulations in a friendly and helpful manner.
- 6. Follow emergency action plan and procedures established in the event of an emergency.
- 7. Maintain order in the pool and adjoining areas.
- 8. Inspect facilities for cleanliness; complete general pool cleaning and maintenance duties.
- 9. Provide general information on pool operation to members.
- 10. Maintain an acceptable appearance and attitude at all times. The following uniform is required for men: issued or red swim suit and whistle. For women: issued or red swim suit, or red shorts, and whistle. No bandanas while on
- 11. Maintain a high standard of customer service, extending *exemplary service* to all students, including promotion of aquatic programs.

### **MINIMUM JOB REQUIREMENTS:**

CPR Certified; AED Certified; Heimlich Maneuver Certified; Current certification as Lifeguard by the American Red Cross.

## KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES REQUIRED:

- Ability to react calmly and effectively in emergency situations.
- Skill in the application of lifeguarding surveillance and rescue techniques.
- Knowledge of CPR and emergency medical procedures.
- Ability to follow routine verbal and written instructions.
- Knowledge of customer service standards and procedures
