- 4. Collect money and ID cards during meal, makes report of lunches and collections, and tabulates paid, free, and reduced price meal count.
- 5. Participate in training programs.
- 6. Keep area neat and clean.
- 7. Perform related duties and responsibilities as requested by Director or supervisor.
