Position Summary

The Elementary Specialist & Interventionist is responsible for designing and delivering innovative and engaging lessons that support elementary students in developing critical thinking, creativity, problem-solving, and collaborative skills through hands-on, project-based learning that extends the curriculum. - Develop and implement age-appropriate, standards-aligned curriculum for elementary students in grades 3-5 in an Interventionist role.
- Plan and deliver lessons that integrate inquiry-based and experiential learning.
- Utilize a variety of teaching strategies to engage diverse learners.

Classroom Management:

- Establish a safe, inclusive, and supportive learning environment.
- Manage classroom resources effectively.

Collaboration and Professional Development:

- Work collaboratively with grade-level teachers.
- Serve as a resource for colleagues by sharing instructional strategies and best practices.
- Participate in professional learning opportunities to stay updated on education trends and advancements.

Assessment and Evaluation:

- Assess student progress using a variety of formative and summative tools.
- Provide constructive feedback to students and maintain accurate records of performance.
