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Primary Purpose:

Provide instruction to student athletes; developing and enhancing athletic skills to successfully compete in athletic competitions.

Qualifications (Experience/Education/Certification):

Bachelor's degree and valid Texas teaching certificate. Knowledge of assigned sport (coaching or participant experience preferred). **PfISD expectation** is for coaches new to the district to have or obtain a Commercial Driver's License.

Major Responsibilities:

- 1. Use a variety of instructional techniques to meet the needs and improve the abilities of student athletes in the sport assigned.
- 2. Manage and supervise athletic activities, contests, and practice sessions.
- 3. Work with other members of school staff to plan and put in place instructional goals and objectives to ensure the overall educational development of student athletes.
- 4. Take all necessary precautions to protect student athletes, equipment, materials, and facilities.
- **5.** Keep informed of and ensure compliance with all UIL rules and local policies.
- **6.** Monitor and enforce student eligibility criteria for extracurricular participation.
- 7. Work with the Athletic Director and high school athletic coordinators to support the program at all levels by fulfilling additional responsibilities as needed.
- 8. Accompany and supervise student athletes during athletic competitions in assigned sports at local and on out-of-town trips.
- **9.** Advise students on NCAA regulations with regard to academic requirements for scholarships and recruiting practices.
- **10.** Apply and enforce student discipline during athletic contests, practice sessions, and while on trips off school property in accordance with Student Code of Conduct and student handbook.
- **11.** Drive bus for students to and from athletic events. Maintain CDL and follow transportation procedures expected of the District transportation services.
- **12.** Encourage sportsmanlike conduct in all phases of athletic participation.
- **13.** Promote individual growth in athletic skills, teamwork, and good sportsmanship.
- 14. Establish and maintain open communication by conducting conferences with parents, students, principals, and teachers.
- **15.** Assist in selection of equipment and instructional materials.
- 16. Support in compiling, maintaining, and filing all physical and computerized reports, records, and other documents required.

Special Knowledge/Skills:

- General knowledge of coaching techniques and procedures.
- Knowledge of University Interscholastic League (UIL) rules and local athletic policies and procedures.
- Ability to instruct and supervise student athletes.
- Excellent organizational, communication, and interpersonal skills.
