Reed-Custer is a unit school district located approximately 25 miles south of Joliet (near I-55). The District has an enrollment of approximately 1,400 students from in and around Braidwood, Essex, Custer Park, and Godley (Illinois). The District has three schools:

- Reed-Custer Elementary School (PreK-5)
- Reed-Custer Middle School (6-8)
- Reed-Custer High School (9-12)

The District offers career and technical education opportunities to high school students through WILCO Area Career Center (Romeoville, IL) and GAVC (Morris, IL).

The District offers affordable daycare / early education services to children of employees.

The District allows non-resident children of employees to attend district schools without paying tuition.

Board of Education

The Reed-Custer Board of Education is comprised of dedicated citizens. The Board establishes sound policies and expects the Superintendent to function as the Chief Executive Officer in regards to implementing those policies. The Reed-Custer Board of Education has mostly veteran members with exceptional experience and tenure. The Board President started in 2005, with the other members starting in 2009, 2011, 2013 (3), and 2023.

Candidates will be evaluated on professional attributes as they relate to District needs. The Board of Education is specifically looking for an educational leader who:

- has finance/budgeting and human resource experience
- has the ability to work closely with other area educational leaders, legislators, and corporate/business leadership

- develops relationships and works collaboratively with the BOE, the administrative leadership team, and all District staff to meet District goals/visions
- has excellent written/verbal communication skills
