- 4. Work with parents/guardians to refer students to outside community agencies when appropriate

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- 5. Participate in, coordinate and conduct activities which contribute to the effective operation of the school to include Fair Share responsibilities
- 6. Coordinate yearly assessments
- 7. Pursue professional development
- 8. Perform other duties as assigned by the building principal
