Notify media of sporting events, scores, news items, before and after games or events. • Ensure that student athletes meet eligibility rules. • Ensure that physical evaluation forms and permission forms are properly completed and filed in the Activity Director's office. • Ensure that student athletes adhere to training rules, lettering policies, grade requirements, and rules of behavior. • Ensure the continual supervision of student athletes on the field, in conditioning, and in locker and shower rooms. • Ensure that health and safety precautions are observed during all activities. • Immediately report all major injuries incurred during practice sessions or competition to the Activities Director and Principal. • Ensure proper purchasing, inventory, and care of equipment. • Submit a complete team roster to the Activities Director ten days prior to the first contest. The following items should be included: player's name, year in school, height, weight, and uniform number, where applicable. • Submit a written report of team records to the activities director at the close of each season. • Present a letter of recognition (emblem) to all athletes who meet the necessary requirements. • See that district policies are observed during all activities. • Keep abreast of new information, innovative ideas and techniques. • Obtain advance approval of the Activities Director and Principal for all activities and expenditures. • Adhere to all district health and safety policies, including all precautions of the Bloodborne Pathogens Exposure Control Plan. • Other duties as assigned by the Activities Director, Principal, or other Administrative
